Section 1:

View the Julian Alps from scenic Lake Bled, seat of Tyrolean bishops for 800 years and summer home to Tito and his ruling Yugoslav family. Learn about the glacial events that formed this European locale. Ascend to the cliff-top Lake Bled Castle, a 1000 year old fortress that dominates the area. Take a boat to the ancient, isolated Bled Chapel Island in the lake below. Study the local geology as you descend into the Postojna Caves, second largest in Europe, to explore the underground world of stalactites and stalagmites. Hike down-hill through Plitvice Lakes National Park passing 16 turquoise lakes linked by 92 waterfalls and cascades (weather permitting).

Section 2:

Explore the old town capitals of Ljubljana, Slovenia, (settled by the Romans and later destroyed by Attila the Hun), and Zagreb, Croatia founded in 1094. Explore the Roman forum ruins at Zadar. Visit the Dalmatian coast city of Split built by Roman Emperor Diocletian, and enter the in-tact sections of his 3rd century palace. Explore the beautiful walled city of Dubrovnik, founded in the 7th century on the Adriatic coast, and now a World Heritage Site. In the Franciscan Monastery you will see the world's oldest pharmacy, still in operation. Enter the country of Bosnia-Herzegovina, traveling to the village of Mostar, where you will learn about the Bosnian War (1992-1995), the most devastating conflict in Europe since World War II.

Travel fees include: (per person double occupancy) roundtrip airfare, first class hotels, tours and admission fees, full daily breakfasts, 6 dinners, 1 lunch.

Taxes and airline fees are subject to change.

Locations: Ljubljana (Slovenia) 2 nights, Plitvice (Croatia) 1 night, Split (Croatia) 2 nights, Dubrovnik (Croatia) 3 nights.

Not Included: driver and guide tips. Optional travel insurance: \$139. Single Supplement: \$450. (Very limited availability.) **Dellecave tuition not included.**

Participants are responsible for roommate arrangements. Extensive walking required. Facilities are not handicapped accessible. Valid passports required, not expiring before 11/1/12. Reservations must be made in name exactly as it appears in passport. Course credit requires a pre-departure class. Date to be announced.
