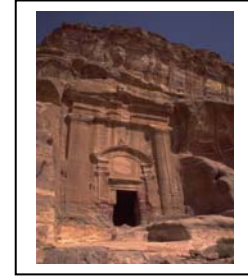

Section 1:

Visit the Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth. Ride on the Sea of Galilee. See the site of The Wedding Feast of Cana. Visit Tabgha, site of the loaves and fishes. Cross the River Jordan. At Capernaum, see the location of St. Peter's house, and the ancient synagogue. Tour such locations as the Mt. of Olives, Last Supper site, and the Garden of Gethsemane. Walk the Via Delarosa (the way of the cross) to the Holy Sepulcher crucifixion site. Visit Jerusalem's old city bazaars. Optional: cross into the Palestinian territories to visit what is accepted to be the oldest active church in the world, at the location of Christ's birthplace in Bethlehem.

Section 2:

See the original Dead Sea Scrolls at the Israel Museum. Explore the Jewish/Christian/Islamic quarters of the walled city of old Jerusalem and have the opportunity to pray at The Wailing Wall. Take the aerial tram up to the plateau-top fortress of Masada. Built by Herod, it was the last stronghold of the Zealots until breached by the Romans in 73 AD. Reach the lowest land level in the world near the Biblical site of Sodom and Gomorrah, and bathe in the mineral waters of the Dead Sea. Ascend to the militarily strategic Golan Heights, now part of the growing agricultural industry, to visit a local winery. Visit a kibbutz to learn about the original and current kibbutz systems. Visit David's Citadel, the Holocaust Museum, King David's Tomb. In Tel Aviv see Rabin Square, the memorial to the Nobel Peace Prize winner, Yitzhak Rabin. Explore the ancient Roman cities of Caesarea and Ben Shean.

Locations: Tel Aviv (1 night), Tiberius (2 nights), Dead Sea /Jerusalem (4 nights)

Section 3:

Explore mystical Petra, Jordan. Built over 2000 years ago as the Nabatean capital, Petra is one of the worlds most marvelously preserved archeological sites. The rose colored facades are carved out of the narrow rock face. This mortuary city of awe-inspiring palace, temple and tomb exteriors is deep into the mountain ravine. It requires extensive walking though uneven roadways. Visa fee of approximately \$50 is required at the Jordan/Israel border.

Locations: Tel Aviv (1 additional night at beginning), Eilat on the Red Sea (2 nights at end of trip).

Travel fees include: (per person double occupancy) roundtrip airfare, first class hotels, tours and admission fees. Israel: **16 meals** (7 breakfasts, 7 dinners, 2 lunches). Petra extension: **4 meals** (3 breakfasts, 1 dinner).

Taxes and airline fees are subject to change. Airline departure and arrival times are accurate at time of this notification.

Single Supplements: (Very limited availability.) Israel \$550; Petra \$100 additional.

Not Included: optional driver and guide tips. Optional ½ day Bethlehem excursion (approximately \$30). Optional travel insurance: \$139. Jordan visa fee for Petra extension: \$50. **Dellecave tuition not included.**

Participants are responsible for roommate arrangements. Extensive walking required. Facilities are not handicapped accessible. Valid passports required, not expiring before 9/1/12. Reservations must be made in name exactly as it appears in passport. Course credit requires a pre-departure class. Date to be announced.
