Measles, Mumps & Rubella  
Compliance**

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New York State Law requires college students to be immunized against measles, mumps and rubella. The law applies to all students taking six or more credit hours born on or after January 1, 1957.

Crandall Health Center must have written proof of immunity against measles, mumps and rubella for all students taking six or more credit hours on campus or off campus. Without this documentation, you will not be allowed to attend classes, live in a residence hall or participate in any sports or extracurricular activities after the stipulated grace period.

**Places to go to find your Immunization Record:**

- Health Center at previous college attended
- High School
- Elementary School
- Pediatrician
- Primary Care Physician
- Camps attended
- Parents/Guardian

**Acceptable proof of immunity consists of:**

**Measles**

- Dates of two doses of live measles vaccine. The first dose must have been administered on or after your first birthday and the second dose at least thirty days after the first dose and after fifteen months of age.

or

- Physician verified history of measles disease.

or

- A blood test showing immunity against the measles disease.

**Mumps**

- Date of one dose of live mumps vaccine administered on or after your first birthday.

or

- Physician verified history of mumps disease.

or

- Blood test showing immunity against the mumps disease.

**Rubella**

- Date of one dose of live rubella vaccine administered on or after your first birthday.

or

- A blood test showing immunity against the rubella disease.

*Note: A physician verified history of rubella disease is not acceptable.*
