ORIGINS OF THE AGE OF EXPLORATION**
3 in-service or graduate credits (45 hours)

Section 2: SPANISH CULTURE AND TRADITIONS
3 in-service credits (45 hours)

MADRID, CORDOBA, SEVILLE, GRANADA

Both sections require a pre-departure class at Dellecave. Date to be announced.

Section 1: Through first hand visits to some of Spain's most important locales, participants will gain a fuller knowledge of events that propelled the nation's into The Age of Exploration. They will take part in both orientation and in-depth visits to Spain's major cultural and historical areas. They will explore Madrid's capital and museum districts, including the Royal Palace, Puerto del Sol Plaza and Plaza Espana with its monument to Cervantes. In Seville (the ancient capital of Roman Spain) and Cordoba they will discover the Moorish capitals with their distinct African influences. They will learn about the origins of the exploration period while they visit Seville's gothic cathedral which holds the remains of Christopher Columbus.

Section 2: Participants will explore Seville's Santa Cruz Quarter, dating back to the Middle Ages. Here they will spend an evening learning about the origins of Spain's traditional dance, the flamenco. They will visit Cordoba's Mesquita, formerly a Moorish Mosque and now the city's main cathedral. They will visit the medieval Jewish Quarter with its ancient synagogue. In Granada they will study the architecture of the Alhambra, a 13th century complex of palaces and fortifications, with its opulent harem rooms and lavish baths. They will also discover the extravagant Generalife water gardens.

(Sections 1 and 2) travel fee: \$2245 (per person double occupancy) roundtrip airfare, airport transfers, hotel, daily breakfasts, three dinners, tours and admission fees.
 Scheduled nights: Madrid (2), Cordoba (1), Seville (2), Granada (2), Madrid (final night).

Not included: Departure taxes and airline fees, presently **\$295**. (subject to change.)

Additional Options: Optional travel insurance (\$129). Optional driver and guide tips.

Participants are responsible for roommate arrangements. Valid passports required, good for six months beyond departure date. Reservations must be made in name exactly as it appears in passport. Extensive walking required.
