All sections require a pre-departure class at Dellecave. Date to be announced.

Section 1: Participants will explore the life styles of the occupants of the highest mountain range in Europe as they travel through the Germany/Austria/Switzerland border. They will visit such locales as Mozart's birthplace in Salzburg, world famous Innsbruck, and tiny Liechtenstein (6th smallest country in the world). From Lake Lucerne they will climb the Swiss Alps by rail to see Interlaken, Grindelwald and Eiger Mountain. They will also explore classic Neuschwanstein Castle, the most photographed building in Germany, said to be the inspiration for Disney's Sleeping Beauty Castle.

Section 2: In Munich, where Hitler staged his attempted revolution, participants will dine at the Haufbrauhaus, the site of the inception of the Nazi Party in 1920. They will tour Dachau, Germany's first concentration camp. Built in 1933, it held 30,000 prisoners when the allies liberated it in 1945. They will also enter the Berchtesgaden salt mines, (dating from 1517). They will explore Salzburg, the legendary site of The Sound of Music as the Von Trap family escaped to avoid Nazi oppression. In Switzerland participants will come to understand the physical features that allowed the Swiss to assume a centuries old neutrality status in European politics.

Travel fees include: (per person double occupancy) roundtrip airfare, hotels, airport transfers in Europe, daily breakfasts, three dinners, first class coach service, tour and admission fees.

Not included: Departure taxes and airline fees, presently **\$266**. (These fees are subject to change.) Optional driver and guide tips. Optional travel insurance (\$139). **Dellecave tuition is not included in travel fee.**

Participants are responsible for roommate arrangements. Passports must be valid beyond 10/4/10. Make reservations in name exactly as it appears in passport. Facilities are not handicapped accessible. **EXTENSIVE WALKING REQUIRED.**
